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Layout of Day:

- Morning – set up a table of all children's names with columns for each event. If children choose to, they can participate in events to win points (gold, silver, bronze and a participation. Eg. 4,3,2,1 points?)
- Opening Ceremony – children can make flags of a country of their choice (their favourite country or a country of birth) and have a mini 'party' to celebrate the start of the Commonwealth Games/Olympics.
- Each event can be organized in year groups eg. K/1, 2/3, 4/5/6, for fairness. In each event you will have a few gold awards, silver awards and bronze awards and then points for participating.
- Bonus points for participating in every event or showing sportsmanship. Can be worth 5 for example. Encouraging positive behaviour and sportsmanship.
- Afternoon – Closing ceremony – similar to morning but can have ultimate winners with prizes and medals. Winners on a podium with pictures etc.
- Ultimate winners at the end get medals and a prize. Plus prizes can be awarded for special circumstances (helpfulness, participation etc).
