Dear Parents,

We are very pleased by the success of our SMASH (Senior Member After School Hours) Program in the last few years and are very excited to bring you our new program for Term 3 2018! We would like to welcome all of our new members to our SMASH club. If you have any feedback on the previous Term's activities or have any suggestions on how we can enhance your child's time at ENOSHCP, we would appreciate your comments and feedback.

A reminder that for your child to be part of the SMASH Program, the SMASH Club Contract will need to be read and signed by both yourself and your child and returned to the Centre each year. This contract outlines the rights and responsibilities of being part of the club. If you have not signed a contract for 2018, please contact the Centre.

The SMASH Program consists of activities at the centre and special excursions to local venues. In order to attend the excursions, a termly permission note will need to be signed prior to your child attending on the day. If a permission note is not completed by the day, your child will not be able to attend the excursion and will need to stay at the Centre. Unfortunately, we may not have the time on the day to contact parents to seek permission.

NB: Your child needs to bring their Yellow Excursion Hat for ALL SMASH excursions. If you do not have one, please speak with the staff at the Centre to order, prior to your child's excursion date. These hats help us to account for all children and ensure their safety whilst on the excursion- as such, they are a necessity. We appreciate your assistance with this.

If children have a scheduled extracurricular activity that coincides with an in Centre SMASH activity, educators will ensure children still attend their extracurricular activity. If the extracurricular activity coincides with an excursion, the child will remain at the Centre unless written permission is provided to the Centre from the parent advising that their child can miss their extracurricular activity for that day.

The educators and children are very excited about this Program and we hope that the activities will make your child's time here at ENOSHCP a fun and enjoyable one!

Being part of the SMASH program gives you the opportunity to be involved in activities specifically designed for the Year 4/5/6 children.

While at ENOSHCP, I have the right:

- To be safe
- To have fun
- To have age appropriate activities programmed for me
- To have a say in the program
- To be treated fairly and equally
- To be respected
- To have an area that is for the senior children
- To have special activities planned each week for me
- To have our own equipment and resources

While at ENOSHCP, I have the responsibility:

- To respect educators and follow instructions
- To use appropriate language whilst at ENOSHCP
- To be a good role model to the other students of ENOSHCP
- To keep the 4,5,6 area clean and tidy
- To stay within the Centre boundary cones
- To respect the equipment and resources at ENOSHCP
- To show respect to children and educators during roll call
- To set a good example when out in public on an excursion
- To assist other children in following the rules of ENOSHCP
- To assist educators setting up if required
- To help pack away and keep the Centre equipment safe and tidy
- To wear a green wristband and yellow excursion hat whilst on excursions
