Fees

Due to Government subsidies, sessions at Epping North OSHCP are currently free until June 28th 2020. Currently there are no charges in place for absences whilst there are Government recommendations in place for children to stay at home.

COVID-19 changes

Over the past couple of weeks, we have been using a doorbell at the centre to minimise the amount of visitors entering the centre. We are hoping that this is a short-term thing due to the virus. When you arrive at the centre please ring the doorbell and an educator will greet you and sign your child(ren) in/out for you. Thank you to all parents for being understanding about the new process. The children are loving it and can't wait to see who is at the door when they hear the bell ring!

Due to the Governments social distancing protocols, we are encouraging the children to distance themselves when practical such as sitting apart during meal times and minimising games that are close quarters. We are strict in wiping down the surfaces where children have been playing and eating and have been increasing these practices since COVID-19.

As restrictions start to ease and children start to return back to school and OOSH on arrival we will be checking the children's temperature as a precaution. we just want to minimise any risk of transmission.

Emergency Procedures

Week 5 is our emergency procedure week. It works well as we have made a couple of changes to procedures. Each morning and afternoon we practice the emergency procedures of lock downs and evacuations. Whilst we understand these times can be busy, we ask for your patience if an emergency procedure rehearsal is taking place at drop off or collection. We ask that parents please wait until the drill is completed! We really appreciate your patience and understanding. It is crucial for the children and educators to practice the procedure in its entirety to ensure we are all familiar with the correct procedures. We'll be practicing the emergency procedures during this Vacation Care as well, so our non – Epping North students are aware of our procedures.




Shout out to the KIDS.
