hild Care Subsidy: (CCS)

If you are a family who only use Vacation Care, please make sure you have your parent code and password ready to sign in on arrival and when collecting your child in the afternoon. Also, after 8 weeks of not using the centre, Centrelink will cease your account. When you book into pext vacation care and are claiming CCS you will need to re confirm with My Gov, to be able to receive the subsidy.

Parent Code - signing in and out when collecting your child -

Please note that children are not allowed to sign out on the touch screen. You are not allowed to share your parent codes with anyone else, if you would like someone else to pick up your child you will need to add them as an authorised nominee on the webserver. When signing out each parent should have their own log in for example, 1000M is for mother and 1000D is for father and if an authorised nominee is collecting their code will be a 5-digit number. ie; 54321. It is important you sign out using the correct log in, if we ever have to look back on records when a child was picked up by a parent and parents are not using the correct log on we won't get an accurate result. If you need your parent log in to be re sent please see Kareena, Jake or Megan and we will help you

Emergency Procedures

Week 5 is our emergency procedure week. It works well as we have made a couple of changes to procedures. Each morning and afternoon we practice the emergency procedures of lock downs and evacuations. Whilst we understand these times can be busy, we ask for your patience if an emergency procedure rehearsal is taking place at drop off or collection. We ask that parents please wait until the drill is completed! We really appreciate your patience and understanding. It is crucial for the children and educators to practice the procedure in its entirety to ensure we are all familiar with the correct procedures. We'll be practicing the emergency procedures during this Vacation Care as well, so our non - Epping North students are aware of our procedures.

SMASH (Senior Members After School Hours) Program

Welcome new members to the SMASH program we know the children are eager to get to Smash. Smash is a program for Year 4.5 and 6 they do excursions and incursions throughout the term. Please make sure you return the Smash contract and permission note so you don't miss out, we will have some forms printed out at the centre. Each afternoon there is an activity program on for the children to participate in for example cooking, capture the flag, pacman, sometimes they watch a movie and play Wii, participate in craft activities and team building activities.

Extra-Curricular

If your child is going to be doing Band, Dance, chess, Taekwondo and tutoring in the afternoon's we need to have a extra circular form filled out by the parent and signed, if we don't have a form for your child they will not be attending. For kindergarten -
