Vacation Care Highlights

We wish to thank all our parents and children for another two very successful Vacation Care program this Year!! It was very busy, as always, but overall very successful and we have had some very positive feedback from both our parents and children.

We enjoyed many highlights across the Vacation Care weeks, including excursions to ANZ Stadium, Blaxland park, Sydney Olympic BMX track, and Sky Zone, incursions with magician Magic Craig, Make My Bear and Kapow Kamp and in centre days including Nerf Day, Colour Run and Splashtastic days to name a few. We were also very excited to welcome many of our new Kindergarten children from Epping North and our surrounding schools to our Vacation Care program in 2018 and we very pleased with how well they had settled in.



Waitlist and Capacity

As many of our parents will be aware, for the first time in recent years we have hit our licensed capacity of 95 children on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday afternoons, meaning for this session we have a waitlist for places. Currently it is Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday afternoons that has a waitlist however Thursday afternoon is also very close to capacity. We are in the process of increasing our cap to accommodate these places however this may take some time to come into effect.

In the meantime, we are asking all our families to please give us as much notice as possible if you know your child is away, so we can offer places to families on the waitlist as early as possible.

We would also encourage families to make Vacation Care bookings as early as possible to avoid missing out, as we may have days that will fill up.

Extra-Curricular Activities

Just a reminder to our Epping North families to fill out an extra-curricular activity permission note if your child has a music lesson or other activity during the week. There have been a few cases of children having activities on without written permission from their parents. Please ensure your forms are up to date as we can not always guarantee we will have time to chase up parents for permissions in the busy mornings or afternoons.

SMASH (Senior Members After School Hours) PROGRAM

Our SMASH program continues in 2018 for our Year 4, 5 and 6 children with tailored activities each session that our older children will enjoy. Our lucky new Year 4's are already enjoying the activities and excursions and making the younger children even more jealous! These activities range from board games, to cooking or making food, organised sport or games at the COLA and top oval and of course our weekly program which includes our excursions around the community. In Term 1, some of our excursions included: netball and tennis at North Epping Oval (Week 4), a trip to the bakery for milkshakes and a pastry (Week 6) and a cooking workshop in Week 9.
