We ask that parents please wait until the drill is completed! We really appreciate your patience and understanding. It is crucial for the children and educators to practice the procedure in its entirety to ensure we are all familiar with the correct procedures. We'll be practicing the emergency procedures this during Vacation Care as well, so our non - Epping North students are aware of our procedures.

SMASH (Senior Members After School Hours) Program

Our SMASH program continues in 2019 for our Year 4, 5 and 6 children, with tailored activities each session that our older children enjoy.

Please be aware that a new permission note comes out every term, which means each SMASH family should be handing in a new permission note every term. There will be some permission notes located in the centre near the touchscreen which you can fill it out when signing your child in/out. If your child does not have a permission note for the excursion, they will not be able to attend. This term SMASH will go on an excursion to our very own local pizza shop to learn how to make pizza. In week 8 SMASH are off to Strike at Macquarie for an escape room to see if they can crack the code.

Class Dojo OOSH Tokens
