## **Upcoming Vacation Care Dates:**

#### **Summer December / January Vacation Care Dates are:**

Last day of school is Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> December Before and After School Care, we will be open as normal.

Vacation care will be open Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> December and Friday 20<sup>th</sup> December 2019.

The centre will be closed from Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> December until Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> January 2020.

Fild Care Subsidy: (CCS)

If you are a family who only use Vacation Care, please make sure you have your parent code and password ready to sign in on arrival and when collecting your child in the afternoon. Also, after 8 weeks of not using the centre, Centrelink will cease your account. When you book into next vacation care and are claiming CCS you will need to reconfirm with My Gov, to be able to receive the subsidy.

We ask that parents please wait until the drill is completed! We really appreciate your patience and understanding. It is crucial for the children and educators to practice the procedure in its entirety to ensure we are all familiar with the correct procedures. We'll be practicing the emergency procedures during this Vacation Care as well, so our non - Epping North students are aware of our procedures.

#### **SMASH**

(Senior Members After School Hours) Program

Our SMASH program continues in 2019 for our Year 4, 5 and 6 children, with tailored activities each session that our older children enjoy.

Please be aware that a new permission note comes out every term, which means each SMASH family should be handing in a new permission note every term. There will be some permission notes located in the centre near the touchscreen which you can fill it out when signing your child in/out. # Class Dojo OOSH Tokens

Last term we introduced class Dojo points as our Oosh token rewards for children. Each couple of weeks we are working closely on an expectation. The children are loving the new class Dojo.

5 points = small prize 10 points = large prize

20 points = they get to change their monster!

If you arrive to pick up your child and they say but wait "I need my class dojo you will know what they are talking about. The children are really adapting to the new OOSH tokens, some children have earned so many they have got to change their character.

As some of you are aware we have recently changed our routine slightly we are know serving afternoon inside for K-2 and the main room is for eating and the hall next door to the main room is for quiet activities.
